Tasmiyah (Reciting Bismillaah)

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ

Translation:

In the name of Allaah, the
Most Kind, the Most Merciful.
(Al-Qur'aan, 96:1)

Begin everything in
the name of Allaah.

Ta'awwuth (Seeking Refuge in Allaah)

أَعُوذُ بِاللَّهِ مِنَ الشَّيْطَانِ الرَّجِيمِ

Translation:

I seek protection in Allaah
from Shaytaan the rejected
one.
(Al-Qur'aan, 16:98)

Recite ta'awwuth
before reading the
Qur'aan and also
for seeking
protection against
Shaytaan.

Kalimah Tayyibah (The First Kalimah)

لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ مُحَمَّدٌ رَّسُولُ اللَّهِ

Translation:

There is none worthy of worship besides Allaah and Muhammad ﷺ is the messenger of Allaah.
(Bazaar)

This is the first understanding of who Allaah and Muhammad ﷺ are.

Names of Islamic Months

صَفْرٌ

It is necessary that a Muslim knows the names of the Islamic months.

Kalimah Shahaadah (The Second Kalimah)

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَشْهَدُ
أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

Translation:

I bear witness that there is none worthy of worship besides Allaah and I bear witness that Muhammad is His Servant and Messenger.
(Bukhaaree)

A verbal declaration of a Muslim's understanding of who Allaah and His prophet ﷺ are.

Salaam

السَّلَامُ عَلَيْكُمْ وَرَحْمَةُ
اللَّهِ وَبَرَكَاتُهُ

Translation:

Peace be upon you and also the mercy of Allaah, and His blessings.
(Al-Qur'aan, 4:86)

By greeting with these words, Muslims make du'aa for each other.

Du'aa before eating

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ وَعَلَيْ بَرَكَاتِهِ

Translation:

In the name of Allaah, and upon the blessings of Allaah.
(Haakim)

In this du'aa, a Muslim thanks Allaah for the food He has blessed us with.

Du'aa when intending to do something

7

إِنْ شَاءَ اللَّهُ

Translation:

If Allaah wills.
(Al-Qur'aan, 18:23)

Nothing can happen without the will of Allaah. Saying this phrase is seeking His assistance and reflects one's helplessness to do something.

Du'aa when thanking someone

جَزَاكُمْ اللَّهُ خَيْرًا

Translation:

May Allaah reward you well.
(Tirmizee)

Goodness deserves goodness and who better than Allaah can grant goodness.

Du'aa after eating

الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَطْعَمَنَا وَسَقَانَا
وَجَعَلَنَا مِنَ الْمُسْلِمِينَ

Translation:

All praise is due to Allaah,
who fed us, gave us to drink
and made us Muslims.

(Tirmizee)

In this du'aa, we
are reminded of
Allaah's 3 favours
upon us, namely:
food, drink and
Imaan.

Du'aa before entering the toilet

اللَّهُمَّ إِنِّي أَعُوذُ بِكَ مِنَ الْخُبْثِ
وَالْخَبَائِثِ

Translation:

O Allaah, I seek protection in
You from Shaytaan.

(Bukhaaree)

We need Allaah's
protection when in
the state of
relieving ourselves.

غُفِرَانَكَ ط الْحَمْدُ لِلَّهِ الَّذِي أَذْهَبَ
عَنِّي الْأَذَى وَعَافَانِي

Translation:

I seek Your forgiveness. All
praise is due to Allaah who
has removed discomfort from
me and granted me relief.

(Tirmizee)

Whilst relieving
oneself, one is not
allowed to make
zikr of Allaah,
therefore we ask
His forgiveness
and thank Him for
allowing us to
relieve ourselves
with ease.
